Wickliffe Progressive Elementary School Feedback

What do you think of the draft interior layout (floor plan) for this school?

- I like commonality w/ Windermere building.
- Like common areas w/ each classroom cluster. Like central library & cafeteria.
- Make the colors totally different for the two new elementary schools (Wickliffe & Windermere).
- Good. Clerestory glass in central dining area needs to be protected for south sun exposure.
- Fantastic! It's flexible, collaborative and future thinking.
- Interested in the gym layout. Public access for after hours events and after school programs not evident. Layout of locker room for sports teams. Can they accommodate travel teams?
- I like it! It's compact, and I like how it keeps classes together in the pods - great concept.

What do you think of the initial design for the exterior of this school?

- Great.
- A little plain - would like to see some character.

- I like that it has echoes of the existing school design while being modern.
- Concerned with active shooter situations. Current available options include active shooter pods within classrooms that cost \$20K per shelter and withstand F5 tornado.
- The design of the building seems attractive - it should be an asset to the neighborhood.

What do you think of the draft site layout (parking, playgrounds, etc.) for this school?

- Great.
- Like trees & multiple activity areas.

- I think it will be much more fluid and easier.
- Proposed drop-off / pick-up does not alleviate issues with traffic congestion. Interested in fencing options for playgrounds, especially hard surface to protect spaces. Questioning the elimination of baseball field?
- It looks like it leaves a nice amount of open area for play & gathering.

- Be prepared to handle “complainers.” Some people naturally want to complain. People need to understand there will be 1-2 years of pain for a bright future.
- Concerned about 2 schools on one site (even for a year).

Windermere Elementary School Feedback

What do you think of the draft interior layout (floor plan) for this school?

- Make the colors totally different for the two new elementary schools (Wickliffe & Windermere).
- Looks good.
- Drawings of Windermere look outdated & much like what is already there.
- I like the studio areas with places for collaboration.
- I like how it is arranged with classrooms & common areas (in four pods).
- I love that the library is central and kind of the “hub” of the academic area.

- + Pod classroom layout w/ open space for grade level collaboration. + flexible small group spaces. ? will it always be a 4 classroom / grade school? This setup makes it difficult to add a 5th classroom w/out feeling cut off.
- + □□ Media center is heart of it all! Yes! Glass! Real light! Yes! Collaborative spaces! Flexible! Teaching practice to follow! (T) leader vs. (T) facilitator.

What do you think of the initial design for the exterior of this school?

- Institutional. Hopefully material selection & color can off-set how the building is appearing in CAD.
- It lets in a lot of light.
- Looks undeveloped. I'll save my comments for down the road when the design team has developed the exterior further.
